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ACT ONE

EXT. SMITH HOUSE - DAY

Steve and JEANIE a cute attractive girl walk to the door holding hands

STEVE

You didn't have to walk me to the door
Jeanie.

JEANIE

What kind of date would I be if I
didn't make sure you got home safe?

STEVE

How'd I ever get someone as good as
you?

JEANIE

Guess you're lucky.

STEVE

I sure am.

Steve gives her a cute peck on the cheek. She slaps him hard on the butt, he lets out an erotic squeal.

JEANIE

Now get in there.

INT. SMITH LIVING ROOM - SAME

Steve closes and leans against the door in ecstasy.

FRANCINE

How was your date sweetie?

STEVE

The best.

FRANCINE

Well I've got some snacks ready, but since you had such a good date. Do you want your celebratory grilled cheese?

STEVE

With the crust cut off?

FRANCINE

How else would my big little man have it?

Francine gets up and goes to the kitchen.

FRANCINE (CONT'D)

There's ants on a log on the table, if you're hungry now.

STEVE

I am.

Steve sits down and begins eating the celery sticks. Klaus watches Steve from his bowl. Roger sits in a chair.

KLAUS

Look at Steve, de lady killer.

ROGER

Steve, I'm hungry pass those over here.

STEVE

No Roger, these are for men that go on dates. Not losers like you.

KLAUS

Oh burn.

ROGER

(LAUGHS) I'm going to pretend I didn't hear that. Give me the snacks.

STEVE

You go on a date you get snacks. And looking around I'm the only one here that's been on a date. Not that anyone would date you.

ROGER

Wish you really wouldn't have said that.

STEVE

Get used to it I'm the man now.

ROGER

The man really? Franny sure is taking a while on that grilled cheese. It normally doesn't take her this long. Maybe the man should go check on her.

STEVE

Fine, I will, but not because of that. It's because ... I'm all out of celery.

Steve shoves four celery sticks in his mouth, almost choking.

KLAUS

Oh now I get what the girls see in you Steve.

INT. SMITH KITCHEN - SAME

Steve enters gasping for air. Roger follows him.

ROGER

Oh that's strange no grilled cheese,
and no Franny.

STEVE

I'll admit that is strange, but there
is likely an explanation.

Klaus pushes through in his bowl.

KLAUS

What I miss, where's that awesome
grilled cheese?

STEVE

She's not here.

KLAUS

What!?

ROGER

Where could she be? Maybe we should
follow the breadcrumbs?

STEVE

There aren't any.

ROGER

Then follow the bread.

Roger throws the loaf at the door.

STEVE

We still need that.

Steve grabs the bread and stares outside.

STEVE (CONT'D)

There's Mommy. What's she doing
outside?

Roger peers over Steve's shoulder.

ROGER

It's almost like she's talking to
someone.

EXT. SMITH BACKYARD - SAME

Francine talks to Jeanie.

JEANIE

And then he kissed me. That was never
part of the deal.

FRANCINE

I didn't think he had it in him.

JEANIE

I hit him, but I think he liked it.

FRANCINE

Yes, we had to stop spanking him,
after the incident.

JEANIE

It's going to be an extra fifty. And
twice as much on the next date.

FRANCINE

That sounds fair.

Francine takes cash from her purse.

STEVE

Mommy?

Francine and Jeanie turn to see Steve at the door.

STEVE (CONT'D)

What's going on Mommy? Why are you
paying her?

FRANCINE

It's nothing sweetie. I'm just buying
... Girl Scout cookies.

JEANIE

What?

FRANCINE

I'll have ten thin mints.

STEVE

Mom!

ROGER

Bravo Franny. Steve will totally
believe that lie. He'd never guess
you're paying girls to date him.

Whoops, did I let that out?

Steve cries and runs inside.

FRANCINE

Let Mommy explain Sweetie!

Francine runs in after Steve.

JEANIE

Am I still getting paid?

ROGER

You got any of those Girl Scout
cookies?

INT. STEVE'S ROOM - SAME

Steve's head buried in his pillows cries.

ROGER

What's the matter buddy?

Roger holds a plate of grilled cheese at the door.

STEVE

I can't believe it. I was dating that
girl for weeks, and Mom was just
paying her.

Roger sits on the bed with Steve.

ROGER

If it makes you feel any better it
wasn't the first time.

STEVE

Not the first time?

ROGER

Steve it's no big deal, your Mom's
only done this --

STEVE

What? Two, three, how many times I
have to know? Tell me!

ROGER

Always.

STEVE

Always, what?

ROGER

She always pays for your dates.

Forever since your first one.

Montage - Francine paying Steve's dates.

- Steve in Kindergarten, Francine pays a little girl money. The little girl goes over and hugs him.

- Francine pays Debbie a fist full of cash. Debbie runs to Steve and they make out.

- Francine hands a stack of cash to various girls in quick succession.

BACK TO SCENE:

Steve rocks back and forth in his bed.

STEVE

I can't take it anymore.

ROGER

What's it matter you got girls?

STEVE

But it means no girl ever truly liked me.

ROGER

No, not without money, no.

Steve cries harder. Roger pats Steve's head.

ROGER (CONT'D)

Steve the family will always see you as the baby. Unless you can prove otherwise it's never going to change. You need to become a real man like me. Then the family will take you seriously.

STEVE

Is that true.

ROGER

Sure buddy and then you'll have no
problem with the girls.

Roger reaches down and realizes his plate is empty.

ROGER (CONT'D)

Francine I'm out of snacks!

FRANCINE (O.S.)

I'll make you some more come on down!

Roger trips off the bed, and hits the ground hard.

ROGER

Franny I fell!

Roger runs out of the room crying.

FRANCINE (O.S.)

Oh did you have a boo-boo? Do you want
your special boo-boo snack?

ROGER (O.S.)

And my ow-ee martini.

INT. STAN'S STUDY - DAY

Stan sits at his desk making a wood model house. Hayley
knocks on the open door.

HAYLEY

Hi Dad, what are you doing?

STAN

I'm building a fact simile model of
greatest president's fifties style
ranch house. George Bush Junior.

HAYLEY

You're building a toy house?

The room is filled with model houses.

STAN

No, it's a model. And I'm very busy so
leave.

HAYLEY

Not till you look at this.

Hayley places an old wrinkled paper on the desk.

STAN

What's this?

HAYLEY

I was cleaning my room and found this
Father Daughter coupon.

STAN

(LAUGHS) Oh how silly, did I actually
write this?

HAYLEY

Yes, and I never used it.

STAN

Just goes to show how good things were
between us. Well you can go now.

HAYLEY

Oh no, this says it never expires and
you have to do whatever I choose.

STAN

You can't expect me to honor a coupon
I made for you, just because I forgot
your birthday.

HAYLEY

You only gave this to me because you
forgot my birthday?

STAN

I always forgot your birthday. Why do
you think you got so many birthday
balloons with Rocket written on them?

HAYLEY

I thought that was my nickname?

STAN

That I only called you on your
birthday? No, that was the gas station
I got the balloons from.

HAYLEY

Gas station?

STAN

Rocket gas. Crap gas ended up killing
my car. Had to stop going. That's why
you got this coupon instead. I had to
think of something.

HAYLEY

This is eye opening. But this coupon
says it never expires.

STAN

You expect me to go on a Father
Daughter day with you when you're how
old? How old are you now? I want to
say ...

HAYLEY

Nineteen.

STAN

Right, nineteen.

HAYLEY

My birthday is in three weeks. And

STAN

INT. SMITH KITCHEN - DAY

FRANCINE

toast, hotdog omelets, Fruity Pebbles
pancakes.

STEVE

Not today Mother.

FRANCINE

Is there something else you would
like? I can make it.

(MORE)

FRANCINE (CONT'D)

Tell me what it is. It's my way for
apologizing for what you saw.

STEVE

I came to realize something last
night. After I was cried out and
pleasured myself to completion five
times.

Steve stands at attention.

STEVE (CONT'D)

Starting today I will become a real
man, that can get a girl himself
without the help of his Mother. And go
all the way. She'll kiss me.

ROGER

That's not really all the way, but
okay.

STEVE

Today a new man is born and his name
is Steven Anita Smith. Watch out
Ladies!

Steve rips off his robe revealing his naked body.

ROGER

Oh Steve you've got a few pubes. Meow.

STEVE

Adieu.

Steve marches in triumph out of the room, Hayley drops her
spoon.

HAYLEY

I can't eat anymore.

ROGER

More for me! It's a eating
competition.

Roger goes hog wild on the food.

FRANCINE

Slow down Roger!

ROGER

Don't worry Franny, I can do this.

Roger's face turns green and he pukes all over the table.
Roger passes out on the floor.

FRANCINE

I'll get a mop.

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO**INT. SCHOOL - DAY**

Steve strolls down the hallway decked to the nines. Proud, he saunters up to Toshi, Snot and Barry at the lockers.

STEVE

Morning fellas.

SNOT

Steve what's gotten into you?

STEVE

Snot, be prepared to see me reel in the ladies.

SNOT

What about your current girlfriend, won't she be mad?

STEVE

You might find this hard to believe, but my mother was paying that girl to go out with me. All the girls I've ever dated. But no more. I'm independent now. So just sit back and watch this stud with the women.

Steve walks away.

SNOT

Steve's Mom is still going to pay us to hang out with him though right?

BARRY

If she doesn't we'll have to find a new best friend.

TOSHI
(in Japanese)

What are you talking about? I keep
paying her so he'll stop hanging out
with us.

SNOT

You're right Toshi. We need to keep an
eye on him.

In confidence Steve moseys up to a group of girls.

STEVE

Hello ladies. Would any of you care
for the most romantic evening, with
the stud meister? I was thinking
bowling, at Dave and Busters this
Thursday for two, with bottomless
nachos.

TEENAGE GIRL 1

How much is your Mom paying?

STEVE

Oh no, she's not paying anymore, this
is all me.

TEENAGE GIRL 1

How much are you paying?

STEVE

I'm paying with love. All you can
have.

TEENAGE GIRL 1

Eww, gross.

She spits on him and they walk away.

STEVE

That's okay I can't just start at the
top. Best to lower my expectations a
little.

Montage - Steve with girls popularity dropping more and more.

- Steve with the debate team. He is pushed back and forth
between the podiums.

- Steve with the goth girls, they put a cigarette out on him.

- Steve with the math club. They beat him with calculators.

- Steve with a club for pregnant teen moms. They beat him
with plastic babies.

-Steve tries hitting on a girl in a wheelchair. She rolls
over him, back and forth.

INT. SMITH LIVING ROOM - DAY

Steve walks through the door his clothes disheveled and face
bruised. Roger eats celery sticks.

ROGER

Whoa. What happened to you? Is that
forth grader still picking on you?

STEVE

No, the girls.

ROGER

The forth grade girls?

STEVE

All the girls. As soon as they find
out Mom isn't paying. They beat me up,
for wasting their time.

ROGER

Well what did you expect? Why would
they buy the cow, when the cow's
Mother pays them to take the milk.

STEVE

At this rate no girl will ever go out
with me.

ROGER

Cheer up, I made you an online dating
profile.

Roger hands Steve the phone.

STEVE

Li'l Steve fourteen. You made that my
profile name?

ROGER

Oh yeah. It's good, and you're already
getting hits.

Roger swipes on the phone to a photo of him in a wig.

ROGER (CONT'D)

Here is Wendy. She can fit a whole
pineapple in her mouth. Now that's
sexy.

STEVE

That's obviously you.

ROGER

No, no it's not.

Steve looks at the phone, and back up at Roger now dressed
like the woman on the phone.

ROGER (CONT'D)

STEVE

ROGER

I'm very happy to meet you. And I just
want to say I have no gag reflex.

Roger sticks his arm down his throat, and immediately throws
up all over the room.

STEVE

Not happening.

Roger slips and falls in the vomit crying.

ROGER

Roger runs away crying. Klaus swims up in his bowl.

KLAUS

You know if you want, Steve, I can
show you how to date.

STEVE

No offence but I think I can do better
than a fish.

KLAUS

Not if you want to date anyone besides
Roger. Are you forgetting I used to be
one of the top Olympic ski jumpers in
Austria.

EXT. SKI SLOPE - DAY - (FLASHBACK)

Human Klaus skis into frame.

KLAUS (V.O.)

De Mädchen were all over me. They
would throw their wool gloves and
socks at me all de time.

Wool clothing falls around Klaus. A wool sock lands on his head. He takes it off and inhales deeply.

INT. SMITH LIVING ROOM - DAY - (BACK TO PRESENT)

Klaus reminisces in his bowl.

KLAUS

It makes me warm, putzen, just
thinking about it.

STEVE

Well that's good for you.

KLAUS

Even as a fish I still get down. Don't
you wonder where I disappear for days?

STEVE

It's actually never crossed my mind.

KLAUS

Oh Steve. Playing it cool. Here let me
show you my latest prize.

Klaus swims down to his treasure chest and pulls out a woman's G-string he hands to Steve.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

See.

STEVE

Wow really? But I never see you with
women.

KLAUS

That's because I'm a lone wolf. A one night kind of guy. I don't like them to get all clingy. I have to cut them loose bro. That's how I roll.

Klaus takes back the G-string and inhales it deeply.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

Tonight I'll take you out and show you how to get one of these for your own.

EXT. WOODS - DAY

Stan drinks coffee from a thermos, next to Hayley and a group of protestors.

STAN

Why are we here?

HAYLEY

To stop Cartwright from chopping down this forest.

STAN

Cartwright from Cartwright presidential models?

HAYLEY

Yes, this forest is going to be used for the building of Ronald Reagan's model house.

STAN

Oh this is some great wood. I can't wait until they chop it down.

HAYLEY

Dad, we're here to stop them.

STAN

You're here to stop them. And I'm gone
after today.

HAYLEY

It's Father Daughter activity. Now
hold this.

She hands him a sign reading "CUTTING KILLS" and she holds
one reading "AXES ARE ASSES".

STAN

Do I have to?

HAYLEY

Do you need to read the coupon again?

STAN

No.

Stan holds up the sign. A LOGGER approaches Stan.

LOGGER

Hey buddy what's your problem?

STAN

I don't have a problem.

LOGGER

That's not what your sign says.

STAN

I'm just here for my Daughter. I
actually like your company and models.

LOGGER

Then why are you here?

STAN

Are you a Dad? Well sometimes you have to hang out with stinky hippies to make your kid happy. But don't worry as soon as the pot runs out, and it gets a little cold they'll all leave.

LOGGER

If they get out of line, we'll have an issue.

STAN

Don't worry these kids couldn't hurt a leaf. That's why they're here.

Hayley unseen pours sugar in a logging truck gas tank.

HAYLEY

(WHISPERS) For mother earth.

Hayley sneaks back next to her Dad.

STAN

Where were you?

HAYLEY

Uh, bathroom.

STAN

I hope you dug a deep enough hole.

HAYLEY

Dad.

STAN

Hey you have Smith genes, and we take strong number twos.

A Workman climbs into the logging truck and turns the key. It explodes, and body parts land at Hayley and Stan's feet.

HAYLEY

I don't understand it was just sugar.

INT. ROGER'S ATTIC - SAME

Roger at his bar pours a cup of coffee, he looks at Klaus.

ROGER

Klaus have you seen my nitroglycerin
sugar? It helps me wake up after my
afternoon heroin.

EXT. WOODS - SAME

The Loggers covered in blood pull out their chainsaws.

LOGGER

Get them!

STAN

Time to go!

Stan drags Hayley into the woods, the Loggers chase them.

INT. DEPARTMENT STORE - DAY

Steve holds Klaus's bowl.

STEVE

I don't know about this Klaus.

KLAUS

What are you talking about? This place
is crawling with women.

Steve and Klaus stand in the middle of the tampon aisle.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

Only chicks no dudes. Perfect place.

A woman walks by them.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

How's it going?

She gives Klaus the stink eye as she grabs a box.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

I see you like heavy flow. I'll show
you something heavy.

She hurries away.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

I'll be here if you change your mind.

STEVE

Lets try somewhere else.

KLAUS

But we just got here bro.

STEVE

I feel uncomfortable.

KLAUS

Fine, we'll go to the next place.

INT. PLANNED PARENTHOOD - DAY

Steve and Klaus sit in the waiting room surrounded by crying teenage girls.

KLAUS

Did you know if you get three
abortions the forth is free?

The girl next to Steve sobs in her hands.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

What number are you on?

STEVE

I don't know if this is going to work.

KLAUS

Just wait someone will need a ride
home. (TO THE ROOM) Whose boyfriend
didn't show up and needs a ride home
after?

All the girls hands go up.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

See Steve you just have to give them a
lift.

STEVE

Klaus I can't drive.

KLAUS

What?

Magazines and tissue boxes are thrown at Steve's head.

INT. COURTROOM - DAY

Steve and Klaus sit in the gallery.

STEVE

What are we doing here?

KLAUS

This place is the best bro.

JUDGE

And with that the divorce is final.

KLAUS

See she's fresh on the market.

The woman before the JUDGE throws her ring at her ex-husband.
She turns and makes out with her lawyer, aggressively.

KLAUS (CONT'D)

Oh dang, he beat us to her. We'll just wait for the next one.

STEVE

Klaus I'm looking for more my age.

KLAUS

Dude divorced women are the best.

The woman and lawyer push files off the desk as they kiss.

STEVE

I'm going home.

KLAUS

But it's just getting good.
